The Association formed in 1992 with the aim of encouraging and promoting the ridden standardbred, tries to cater for all equine disciplines by running shows, training activities, trail riding and a variety of fun and interesting events that we hope to see everyone involved in.

Members also receive regular newsletters that keep them informed about what the Association is doing, plans for future events and educational articles, that coupled with activities are intended to benefit riders, as well as help them with improving the performance of their horses. Space is also available in the newsletters for advertising at no charge.

Your standardbred must have an official Harness Racing Freeze brand, or Microchip number to enable you to join as a riding member of the Association.

Registration also enables you to compete for the highest points gained; Showing, Trail Riding, or the most Versatile Standardbred Awards. High Points Showing awards are divided into four sections. An open and two restricted ridden sections and an Inhand Showing section. Versatility is for Standardbreds that are competing against all breeds of horses, in all disciplines, i.e. Dressage, Eventing etc. (this excludes competing in a standardbred only class) All memberships get 1 free High Points booklets of their choice, additional booklets \$5 per book.

These awards are for a horse and rider combination, so if someone else was to compete on your horse, the points they gain cannot be added to your own, unless they are a financial Member and pay for a separate High Points Registration.

## **High Points Rules and Regulations Showing - Trail Riding - Versatility**

1. All the activities our Association runs, be they Shows, Trial Rides, Training days, Treks, Turnout Days, Video Evenings, Games Days etc. will be counted for points.
2. For all other open shows, events etc. you will be awarded 5 points for every outing / competition.
3. Write all the information in the booklets (spreadsheet) provided and at the end of each season, these spreadsheets MUST be returned to be checked and your points added up. TROPHIES and SASHES are awarded at the end of each season at the Annual General Meeting, for the highest points gained in EACH discipline.
4. For the 2023 – 24 season we will be utilising an electronic version of the booklets, this is a simple spreadsheet that you can download to your computer and save your placings as the season progresses then email the file back at the end of the season.

### **Points are awarded as follows:**

Attendance = 5 points

1<sup>st</sup> = 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 5 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 4 points, 4<sup>th</sup> = 3 points, 5<sup>th</sup> = 2 points, 6<sup>th</sup> = 1 point

Points are awarded for all placings to 6th. This way you don't have to win classes, as long as you compete you get your points.
